### Levitate planning approved for London Arts and Crafts house

Levitate has received planning consent for a new 500m<sup>2</sup> contemporary private home in the grounds of an original Arts and Crafts house in north London.

The new detached house draws on the Arts and Crafts movement and sits on a steeply sloping one-acre site, offering views over the city.

The consent follows a year long pre-application process, during which both building and landscape designs were developed with the local planning authority.

Construction is scheduled for 2017, with a comprehensive refurbishment of the old house undertaken in tandem.
